Once these steps are followed a printout showing your child's school fees will appear. 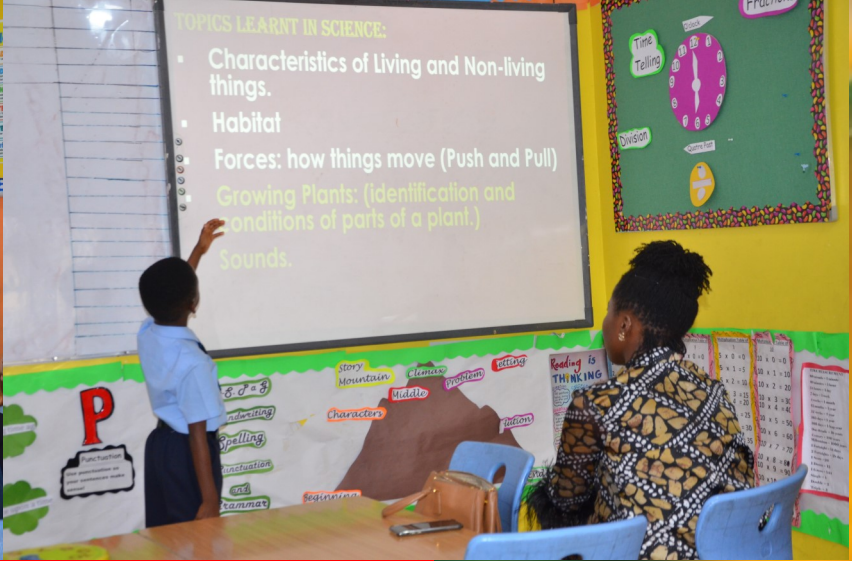
Footwear— The approved school shoe is a plain black, soft sole, no heeled, covered shoe and a plain white or black trainers for P.E.
